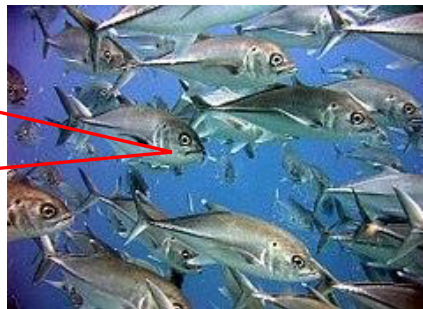
The club:
